

White Cross Deliveries



Two of CBCO's medical institutions who receive White Cross supplies are right here in Kinshasa. This week, I got the privilege of delivering White Cross supplies both to the Health Center in Kintambo (attached pictures - me at the steering wheel) and to the Ophthalmology Clinic which is located right on the CBCO headquarters compound. The 250 pound boxes of bandages take lots of muscle to move! The staff at both institutions asked me to convey their deep appreciation for the ministry of White Cross, which is an invaluable help to the patients they serve.

The supplies to the hospitals in the Bas Congo province were also delivered this week (Sona Bata, Nselo, Kimpesi, and Nsona Mpangu). The medical director of Nselo called to inform me of the safe arrival of the supplies. He also asked me to pass along the thanks of the staff at the Nselo hospital on behalf of their patients. Our hospitals are also thrilled to be receiving the hospital equipment (from Indiana - I believe) which was packed in the White Cross container. Maintenance of equipment is such a challenge, and replacement of the old and broken is most often beyond the financial means of the hospitals. So, again, thank you.
